YOUR WALK-A-THON CHAIRPERSON AND THE REST OF THE COMMITTEE REQUEST YOUR KIND CONSIDERATION IN HELPING US MANAGE THE NEXT FEW WEEKS. The Walk-a-Thon is on a Monday. High School graduation is the following Saturday (Memorial Day weekend). Prize Day is the Tuesday after Memorial Day, May 29th. We have precious few days to process all the checks and properly allocate prize tickets in that short week!

As you know, our 2018 Walk-a-Thon goal is \$75,000. Since our expenses are already almost covered (see the last block for an update on remaining "shoestrings), we're looking for the \$75,000 in the form of sponsorships & pledges.

As of Tuesday, 4/24/18, we've collected \$2,455 in student/family pledges, all in the form of "lump-sum" contributions. Added to the \$6,750 in contributions from Footprint Sponsors and the \$825 from Footstep Sponsors, we've collected a total of \$10,030

towards our \$75,000 goal. We have \$65,000 to go!

Aquinas families who have been around for at least one Walk-a-Thon (some for all 12!), know that we generally use the amount of a Footprint Sponsor as a guideline for how much a family can expect to contribute towards this vital fundraiser. As you know, the Footprint Sponsor amount is \$500. When a family succeeds in securing a Footprint Sponsor, they've succeeded in meeting their \$500 goal. What if your family can't or doesn't want to seek out a Footprint Sponsor?

Each family is different in how they approach raising money for the Walk-a-Thon.

Some have taken advantage of the opportunity to send student pledge letters to family and friends (far away and close to home). The choice to write a "lump-sum" check or a "per-mile" challenge based on the number of laps/miles a student walks/runs is available to those who receive the letter.

Some families prefer to simply write one check on behalf of their child(ren), not reaching out to others in their extended family or neighborhood.

The choice on how to approach participating in the success of the Walk-a-Thon is yours. The key is to participate! The "Tuesday Tidbits" issued by Mrs. Mitros on 4/24/18 remind all of us that "we truly count on a successful Walk-a-Thon event!" Remember, if your child(ren) help raise \$250 in the form of pledges from family and friends, your family contribution is lessened and you don't have to contribute as much out of your own funds. Think about it!

Back to the request from your Walk-a-Thon Chairperson and the rest of the Committee...
