High School students wishing to complete a science project for entry into the Pennsylvania Junior Academy of Science competition will be meeting early in the school year to discuss requirements and assign a mentor if desired.

Regional competitions are held in February followed by State competition in May. Students should plan on having their projects and presentations ready by early January to allow time for practice and revisions.

Although it is advisable to plan the project and even begin gathering data before school starts, there are no requirements or deliverables over the summer. Students should complete the summer reading assignments as required.
